This year's speaker will be Bishop Gerald Wiesner. Bishop Wiesner taught theology at Newman Theological College, and was instrumental in starting the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) in the Edmonton Archdiocese as well as giving dozens of workshops on the process across Western Canada. In 1992 he was appointed Bishop of the Diocese of Prince George. The Lay Formation Program, workshops, study days, retreats and renewal initiatives held in parishes and regions in the diocese give witness to Bishop Wiesner's commitment to adult faith formation. While administrative and pastoral needs in the Diocese of Prince George are a priority, Bishop Wiesner continues to be invited to give workshops and retreats across Canada.
