OFF-CAMPUS EDUCATION

Background

Off-campus education is an opportunity for students to use the community as a resource for schooling. The purpose of off-campus education opportunities is to help the students acquire knowledge, skills and attitudes and gain practical experience related to life skills and career opportunities.

Procedures

- 1. Principals who are providing off-campus educational opportunities for students enrolled in the school shall ensure that they are familiar with, and comply with, Alberta Education Policy 1.4.3 Off-Campus Education and the regulations governing off-campus education.
- 2. Each school offering an off-campus education program shall have a handbook, or kit, outlining the procedures to be followed by the school.
- 3. Off-campus education program applications must be approved by the Superintendent.
