Our Catholic Central High School ELL students are able to learn English while also learning about Canadian customs, values and social expectations. This is done in an environment where they are encouraged to share their cultural experiences and where their cultural contributions are celebrated in the classroom.

ELL students become confident and competent users of the English language by being exposed to as many opportunities to listen, speak, read, write, view and represent the language as possible.
