What Students Need:

- Bike
- Helmet
- Pre-Order BBQ Lunch or bring lunch (canteen will be closed)
- Proper clothing to be outside

All stations and areas will have something that every grade level can benefit from. We will have volunteers from community organizations running each area as well as parent volunteers helping out. Teachers with their class, and any parents from your class can visit and participate in each event.

Safe Riding Zone: Parking Lot

In this area students will learn/review and practice road riding hand signals. We will be using Safety City's street signs to design a course for students to practice on. We will be using the staff parking lot on this day, please keep it clear, THANKS.

Paper Toss Game: Side field by playground

In this area students will deliver the newspaper while riding their bike. There will be targets set up for students to throw rolled up newspapers into.

Race/Obstacle Course: Pond Area

In this area we will have a mini race course set up for students to challenge themselves on. Students will be staggered at the start, so no one runs into anyone else. We will time students and hopefully have small prizes to handout to top racers. For younger or less skilled riders we will also have a mini obstacle course set up to challenge riders. We can time this event as well or just do it for fun and practice.

Skills Area: Bowl

In this area we will set up small obstacles and challenges for students to practice on. Skills we will explore are: pylon serpentine, up and down curbs, track stand challenges, riding skinnies, small jumps (very small), braking techniques, uphill riding technique, downhill riding technique, bunny hops, and if needed how to get on and off your bike safely.
