University of Lethbridge Grade 11 Merit Award

You don't have to wait until you are in Grade 12 to start planning for university, especially if your plans include the University of Lethbridge! The Grade 11 Merit Award is given to students who fill out the online form at <https://www.uleth.ca/ross/student-finance/grade-11-merit-award-application-university-lethbridge> .

This award is calculated using your Grade 11 Average. \$500(75-79%) to \$800 (80% or higher).

Deadline is June 30, 2019. Apply for this award even if you are just thinking about attending the U of L.
