Note that with the exception of Kindergarten, all students have additional teachers for various subject beyond their homeroom teacher; those details will be shared out with students on their first day.

The office is open starting Monday, August 27 between 8:00 and 4:00 pm (closed on Wednesday, September 29 between 9 am and 1 pm for opening mass). All teaching staff return to school on Wednesday, September 29 and can be reached via e-mail or telephone at 403-327-4386 after that time.

If you need school supply list(s) for your child, please select the correct grade from the 'Forms' drop down menu on our homepage at www.holyspirit.ab.ca/st.pat. If you order school supplies from Staples prior to their deadline, they will be at school on the first day.

In addition, if you ordered a 2017-2018 yearbook, it should be at school in early September. Don't worry if you missed out on ordering - extra copies can be purchased in September! Books for past grade 6 students or those who moved away will be delivered to your new school or mailed out.

The first day of school for grades 1-6 is on Tuesday, Sept. 4 starting at 8:35 am. An optional grade 1 orientation takes place in the classrooms on Friday, Aug. 31 from 12-1 pm. Kindergarten students have orientations first and then staggered starts on Monday and Tuesday, Sept. 10 & 11.

Please remember that you are not permitted to park in the drop-off loop at any time for student safety and to reduce congestion. There is plenty of off-street parking around the school, including the lake parking lot. Thank you for your ongoing cooperation.
